Portable Generator Manufacturers Know They Could Make Their Products Safer but Many Don't

Last September, a mother and her two sons died from carbon monoxide (CO) poisoning inside their home after their portable generator's shut-off switch seemingly failed to activate. The generator was on the family's porch instead of being a minimum of 20 feet away from the home, but the unit was also equipped with a supposedly life-saving safety feature. Although the new generator touted the safety mechanism that manufacturers have hailed as preventing as many as 99% of carbon monoxide poisoning-related deaths that result from "misuse," it did not save this mother and her children.

Back in 1989, it was the Texas legislature that made it legal for a single corporation to divide into two or more entities in a move many call the "Texas two-step" today. And the Texas two-step is exactly what Johnson & Johnson, a company worth nearly half a trillion dollars, did last year. It declared bankruptcy in order to secure the majority of its financial assets and to limit its liability in tens of thousands of pending ovarian cancer lawsuits that injured victims have filed against the cosmetic and healthcare product megacorporation.

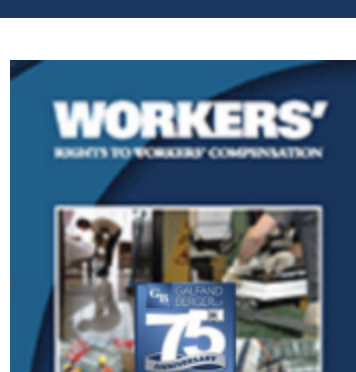
