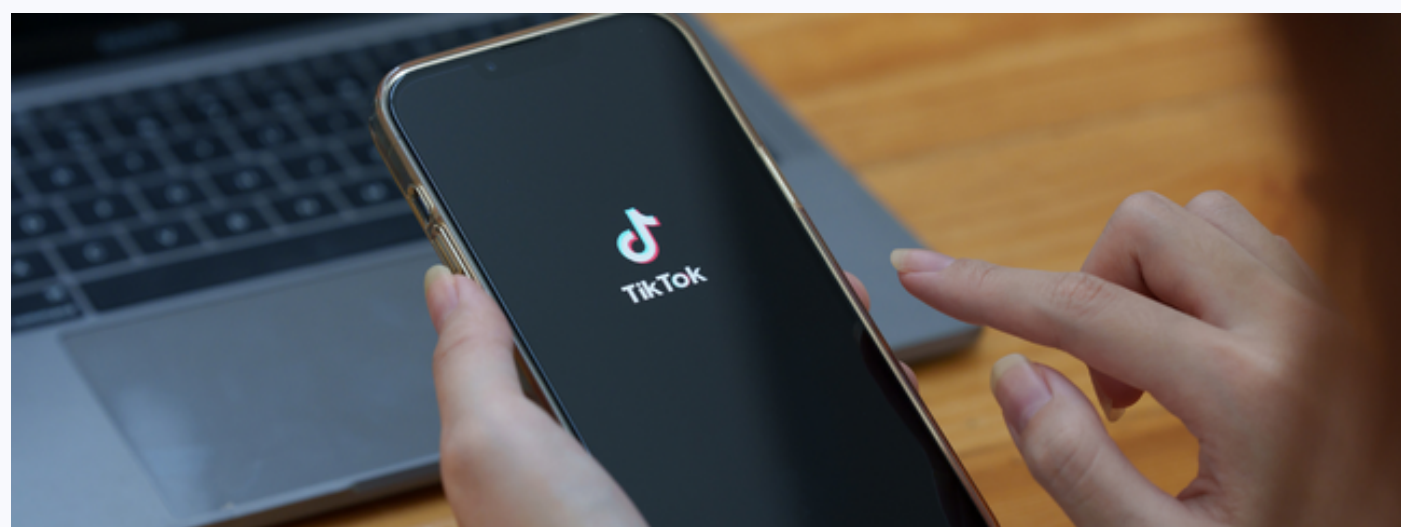


### March is Ladder Safety Month
