Pennsylvania Court Rules CBD Oil Covered Under Workers' Compensation Act

A Pennsylvania appeals court decided cannabidiol (CBD) oil meets the requirements as a supply item for employer reimbursement under the Workers' Compensation Act. The case involved an injured workers' compensation attorney whose doctor prescribed him CBD oil after he sustained a significant work-related back injury. The Court's ruling last month reversed the Workers' Compensation appeal board's previous order, which denied CBD oil as a reimbursable medication and supply.

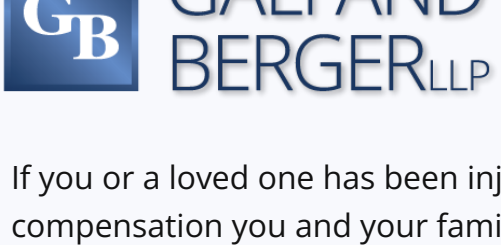
